

Pavetta
cataractarum

Zambezi Bride's-bush

[2 records from 2 squares]

A shrub or small tree. LEAVES obovate to oblanceolate; densely velvety-grey below. FLOWERS white, tubular. FRUIT small, round, velvety; with the remains of the calyx.



The two TAP records were from Bukalo Channel in eastern Caprivi (1724CD) and from Popa Falls on the Okavango River (1821BA). A shrub in the 1–3-m height class, with flowers in December and March. There is one earlier herbarium record from Andara on the Okavango River (1821AB) and two from eastern Caprivi (1723DA, 1823BC).
