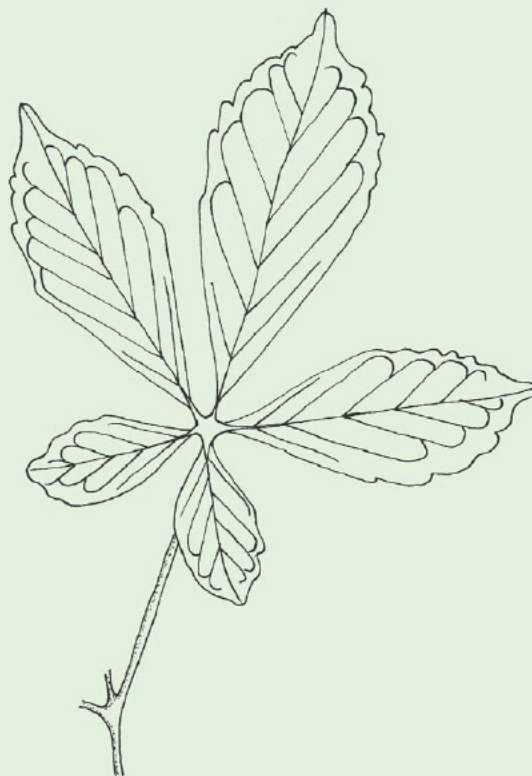


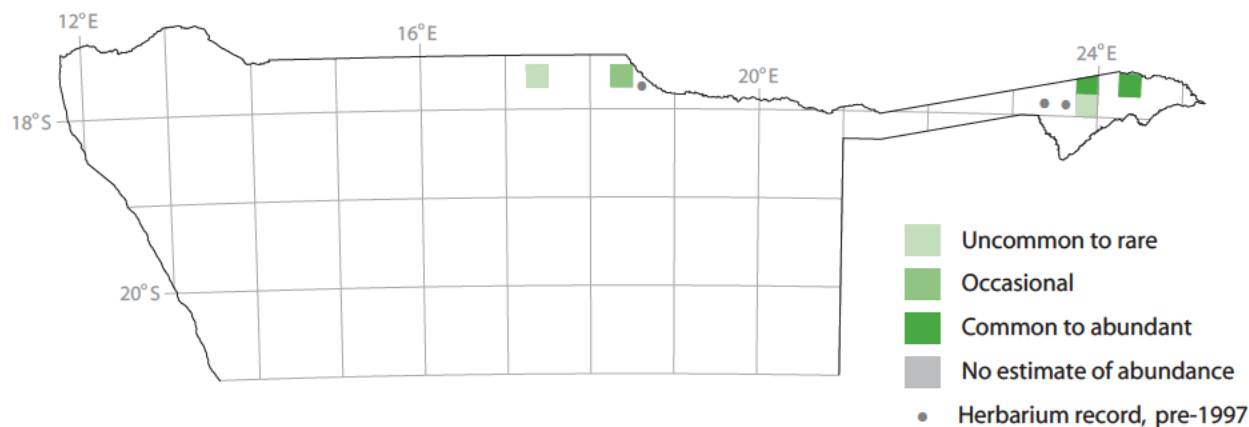
Vitex angolensis

Angolan Fingerleaf

[6 records from 6 (<1%) squares]



Multi-stemmed shrub. LEAVES **palmately compound with 3–7 leaflets**; central leaflet elliptic to narrowly obovate, 30–50 mm long; papery, dark green to yellow-green with yellow hairs on both surfaces; margin entire or irregularly toothed around the upper half. FLOWERS light mauve, two-lipped. FRUIT round or ellipsoid, 15–24 mm diameter, with a persistent calyx; red.



DISTRIBUTION & ABUNDANCE

Occasional in the central-north and common to uncommon in eastern Caprivi.

HABITAT

Unrecorded.

GROWTH FORM

A shrub in the 1–3-m height class.

ANNUAL CYCLE

Only observed in March and April. FLOWERS none recorded. FRUIT and LEAVES recorded in both months of observation.

CONSERVATION CONCERNS

None recorded.
